



COVID-19 Update, April 1st, 2020

Dear Westmount Park Co-owners,

Your Board members have been meeting regularly by teleconference on Mondays and Thursdays at 5 pm to keep on top of the COVID-19 situation and we will continue to do so until the crisis is over.

Exceptionally, we met at 5pm on Tuesday, March 31st, following a co-owner's request for us to consider some additional actions.

The Board decided the following:

- Footbath at the side entrance to disinfect all shoes coming into the building: Since no governmental authority is recommending this, we will not be placing a footbath at the entrance to the building.

We are suggesting that co-owners remove their shoes at the entrance to their own unit and leave them on the inside of their door and not in the hallway.
- We are not yet at the stage of barring all visitors and family members but are strongly recommending that these be discouraged.
- Newspaper deliveries: The current system whereby newspapers are delivered to the door will continue, since this involves less traffic through the building than would occur if co-owners went to the front desk to pick up their newspapers. These deliveries take place very early in the morning and Jean-Denis is very diligent in disinfecting all elevator buttons soon after the deliveries are completed.
- **Contrary to previous bulletins and in view of the challenge in maintaining a distance of six feet between people in the elevator, access to elevators should be limited to one person at a time, except for people who are members of the same household.**
- **Masks:** We are not recommending the use of face masks by co-owners within the public areas of our building. The use of face masks in those areas would tend to give the users a false sense of security and might encourage less than optimal social distancing and hand sanitizing.

Co-owners however, may choose on their own to use face masks in the common areas. If so, you are asked to consider using improvised face masks so as not to encroach on the limited supply of face masks available to our health care workers.

We will continue to update you as to new measures being put into place at WPT to ensure that we all stay as safe as possible.
